

#### MR. CHANG TAI AKANA USAG JAPAN, CAMP ZAMA

Nov. 22, 1952 - June 17, 2022

Chang Tai Akana was born Nov. 22, 1952, in Tokyo, Japan, to the late Mr. Tai Hong Akana and Ms. Kazuko Akana. After having graduated high school in 1972 at Camp Zama, Japan, he did volunteer work from 1978-1980 in Honolulu, Hawaii, at the Easter seals School as a Therapist Assistant and Educational Instructor aiding teachers and supervising children in various course assignments, demonstrating exercises and presenting manual coordination activities. Chang entered federal service in 1981 working at the Naval Supply Center, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, as a Shipment Clerk (typing). In 1982, he moved back to Japan and in May 1983, he began working as an ID checker at the Sagamihara Commissary. He has received numerous awards including Certificates of Achievement, TSA Commanders Winners Circle, Outstanding Handicap Employee of the Year in 1989, and many other letters of appreciation and commendations. During his 39 years working at the Sagamihara Commissary, Mr. Akana performed his duties in an exceptional manner often going above and beyond to serve the Camp Zama and Sagamihara community.

Mr. Chang Tai Akana is survived by his brother, C.K Akana and sister, Yok Lan Di Maio.
